With the Star Breeze arrival, Windstar has exclusively partnered with Pacific Beachcomber's InterContinental Tahiti Resort & Spa in Papeete for convenient pre- and post-cruise stays on the island of Tahiti. The resort has also been incorporated into Windstar's popular Air + Hotel packages from both Los Angeles and Seattle.
