From limoncello oysters and sablefish crudo with pluot and trumpet royale mushrooms to Kamouraska lamb rib eye glazed with coffee and balsamic, the five-course menu promises an unforgettable culinary voyage, paired with world-class wines.

Guests disembark just steps from Old Montreal's cobblestone streets, where landmarks like the Notre-Dame Basilica and Rue Saint-Paul's art galleries, artisan shops, and cafés are all within easy reach.

Montreal is also one of North America's most celebrated food cities, known for everything from beloved staples like poutine and smoked meat to inventive fine dining. With strong airlift and a variety of upscale hotel options, the city serves as an ideal turnaround port, encouraging extended stays before or after a Windstar voyage.
